VOLKER JUOWICH



Volker Juowich is a civil engineer, Technical University, Aachen, Germany. He has been working with a major German international contractor for 35 years, the last 15 as an Executive Director. His responsibilities were part of the local business and all of the international business outside of the European Union.
